




Malay Language & Cultural Camp



02 Bunga Rampai



Students will learn about the use of Bunga Rampai in Malay weddings.

03 Pantun


Students will learn about the structure and the use of Pantun (Malay poetry) to express ideas and emotions, after which they will be guided to create their own couplet.

Students will learn about the history and the use of Kompang in Malay weddings as well as other events.


Students will be shown the different beats of Kompang, after which they will have a hands-on session with the Kompang.
